

SMOKE DETECTORS/SMOKE ALARMS

The purpose of a smoke detector is to provide audible warning of a fire in its early stages while there is still time for you and your family to escape safely. Smoke detectors installed properly and maintained in working order dramatically reduce the risk of dying in a fire.

One (1) smoke detector should be placed on each floor in non-sleeping areas. In addition, one (1) smoke detector must be installed in each room where sleeping occurs and one (1) smoke detector should be located in each hallway that leads directly to sleeping rooms.
(California Building Code Section 310.9.1.4)
