Patio umbrellas must be kept in good condition at all times. If an umbrella is faded, torn, broken, etc. it must be removed or replaced.




## NO CHARCOAL BARBEQUES

# DOG REGISTRATION DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 15th

All dogs residing in the Redwoods <u>or that visit on a regular basis</u>, must be registered with the Redwoods by September 15th or a fine will be imposed to the unit owner.

Currently, the cost to register a dog is \$30.00. After September 15th, the cost for the registration kit will increase to \$40.00.

All registered dogs must have the Redwoods doggie tag (red with white lettering) visible on the dog's collar or leash while in the common areas.
