Master Insurance

Reminder.... Redwood's homeowners required per the CC&R's carry supplemental HO6 insurance policy. The Master Insurance policy for the Association covers the structure of the buildings and does not cover personal contents or homeowner upgrades. If there was a fire, the insurance Example: coverage would restore the building but will not cover your personal items (furniture, clothes, window coverings, appliances, home or personal Additionally, the master accessories, etc.). policy has a \$10,000.00 deductible in which the homeowner filing a claim will be responsible for. Make sure your HO6 policy will cover the \$10,000.000 deductible.


We strongly urge all homeowners to contact an insurance agent to determine if you have the proper coverage. A supplemental "H06 policy" is inexpensive (less than \$300.00 per year) and is money well spent should an unexpected loss occur.
