### Association Owned Carports #175, #305, #307 AUCTION


The Auction will take place on:

#### Qualifications:

- Bidding will start at \$240.00
- Unit owner must be current on monthly dues.
- Winners musts forfeit common area parking space and will only be allowed to park in your 2 carports.
- Winner must pay by check made payable to "The Redwoods HOA". Bidder must have adequate funds in the bank the night of the auction. An NSF check will disqualify that winner and the carport will go to the second highest bidder.
- Tenants must have written authorization from the owner of the unit to be eligible to bid.



### Preparing For The Winter Months

As we do each year in November, all rain gutters will be cleaned and preventative maintenance will be done on our roofs to prevent roof leaks.

Windows are a homeowner responsibility. We recommend that homeowners caulk around your windows, to prevent water intrusion into your home. Caution: make sure the weep holes at the bottom of the window are free of dirt to allow water to drain properly and prevent water from leaking into your home!

## ALL DOGS WHILE IN THE COMMON AEAS, MUST WEAR THEIR GREEN REGISTRATION TAG




All dogs living in the Redwoods are required to be registered with the Association and provide a DNA sample. When registration has been completed, a green dog tag is provided that must be displayed on the dog's collar when the dog is being walked in the common areas. Dog's without the green tag are an indication that the dog may not be registered which is a violation of our pet rules. Our DNA program helps us to minimize the pet waste in our common areas and helps us to hold irresponsible pet owners accountable!

## APPROVED UPGRADES COMING SOON.....

At the October Board meeting the following upgrades were approved:

- Our directory maps in the common areas will be taking on a new upgraded look! We will be replacing the maps for a better appearance and to make it easier for your guests and delivery services to find you!
