
### The Auction will take place on:

- Tenants must have written authorization from the unit owner to be eligible to bid.

This policy is for the structure of the building only and cannot be purchased individually. Please check with your insurance agent for coverage on your personal items, upgrades inside your unit, housing, etc.

### **GARBAGE DISPOSALS**

We have experienced several kitchen sink back-ups recently. Many people don't realize that there is a right way and a wrong way to use a garbage disposal. Improper use can lead to plumbing back-ups.

Cold water is preferred when using a garbage disposal.

Things you should Never put down the Garage Disposal:

- coffee grounds
- eggshells and shell fish
- cooked noodles, quinoa and rice
- corn husks
- banana peels
- shredded lettuce
- oatmeal
- nuts and pits
- onion skins
- celery
- potato peels
- bones
- all fibrous vegetables and peels
- fats, cooking oils, and grease
- large food debris
- paper products or any non-food items

Every so often, run cool water and ice cubes down the drain, along with chopped citrus peels (like from a lemon, orange or lime) for about 60 seconds. This will help push any disposed of items further down the drain and remove any particles left over near the blade that have built up over time, as well as make the disposal smell better.

# Do You Have the Required Insurance?

The Association's master insurance policy covers the building structure but does not cover any personal contents, will not cover any upgrades or improvements you have made to your unit, and does not cover housing should your unit become uninhabitable. Additionally, there is a deductible of \$10,000.00 which the person filing a claim is responsible for.

The Redwood's CC&R's **REQUIRE** that all homeowners carry a personal condominium policy also known as an HO6 policy. Many of these polices will cover the master insurance deductibles, upgrades that have been done to your unit, housing in the event of a loss and special assessments. These policies are inexpensive and money well spent should a loss occur.

DON'T WAIT UNTIL A LOSS OCCURES TO FIND OUT YOU DO NOT HAVE COVERAGE! CONTACT YOUR INSURANCE AGENT TO MAKE SURE THAT YOU ARE ADEQUATELY COVERED IN THE EVENT OF A LOSS.
